- The cost is \$60.00 per household.
- All members of your household, residing at your residence and within our normal call area, will be covered under the membership, excluding employees, tenants, and boarders.
- Bristol Rescue Squad, Inc. reserves the right to any third party billings.
- Additional donations are tax deductible. Donations are acknowledged.
- Any checks received without a subscription application will be considered a donation.
- Memberships are effective from September 1, 2019 through August 31, 2020.

# The Advantages of Subscribing

- Subscription covers twenty-five (25) medically necessary emergency transports for each member residing in your household, twenty-four (24) hours a day, within our coverage area.
- We bill patients' insurances and write off any deductibles, copayments, or the entire amount if the member is uninsured. Patients are responsible for any balances, after the initial twenty-five (25) transports.
- Limited local medically necessary non-emergent transports.

### **MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT**

I hereby apply for Bristol Rescue Squad, Inc. subscription membership for the members of my household listed on the reverse side that reside at my primary residence. I understand that this membership does not cover visitors, employees, tenants or boarders. I understand that the \$60.00 per household per year membership fee provides local emergency medical and emergency ambulance service to me and my dependents as medically needed. This membership covers copayments, deductibles, or uninsured transports for any medically necessary emergency services provided by Bristol Rescue Squad, Inc., which incurs during the subscription year for up to twenty-five (25) transports per covered resident/member. I understand that once the transport limit has been met, I am responsible for all co-pays, deductibles, and uninsured transports.

I understand that the subscription membership expires August 31, 2020 regardless of when I initiated my subscription.

I also understand that this membership permits Bristol Rescue Squad, Inc. to collect directly from any third-party agency, whatever benefits may be available at no charge to me or my family, and that this membership is nonrefundable and is non-transferable.

I further understand that my payment alone is agreement to the above membership rules and limitations.

Thank you for providing the support that has allowed Bristol Rescue to reach our 50th year in operation. It would not have been possible without the continued support of our Towns, and our Subscribers.

Bristol Rescue provides emergency medical services to the Towns of Bristol and Lincoln, as well as parts of Starksboro, Monkton, and New Haven. It is only through your support and our dedicated volunteers and staff that we are able to provide 24-hour emergency service to our communities.
